A Budget Work Session of the Town of St. Armand was held in person at the above date and time at the Town Hall, Bloomingdale, NY, and virtually on-line.

Supervisor Davina Thurston called the Budget Work Session to order at 5:31 pm and asked all to join in saying the Pledge of Allegiance.

- Guest Speakers – Bloomingdale Volunteer Fire Department

The Town Board asked the BVFD to speak at the Budget Work session to discuss their request for the 2026 Fire Contract in the amount of \$60,000.00 with the Town of St. Armand.
